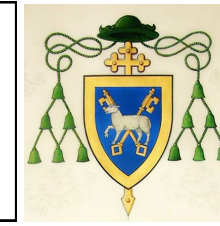

To this end all our volunteers and church personnel have to undergo a vetting procedure and safeguarding training appropriate to their role, which is updated on a regular basis. The Diocese of Down and Connor takes seriously all concerns, suspicions and allegations of child or vulnerable adult abuse made against any member of clergy, staff or volunteers.
